Training Session

It was suggested by KE3ZT, KB3DFZ and others that additional FD points could be earned if there were on-site training opportunities. Therefore all members are invited to attend a classroom session on "Repeater Control." Due to the recent QRM of our two meter repeater by an unidentified "LID", this orientation will be most useful. Those who successfully pass the course, will be given the secret control codes for the repeater for the purpose of power up and power down.

Secondly, there will be a tutorial on proper care and feeding of the NGV Van. Those who wish to become additional drivers of the van will need to successfully complete this course.

K3SCM "DF" Presentation

Jay Williams gave a fascinating talk on VHF "DF" procedures using simple two-meter transmitters and receivers. "DF" or Direction Finding is a highly useful skill to determine the precise location of an unknown transmitter. K3SCM demonstrated the proper use of "Lobes" and "Nulls" using additional gear such as RF attenuators which assist the "Fox Hunter" to locate the transmitter when in the receiver is in the near field. Jay displayed a number of home-brew tuned loop directional antennas which greatly assist the Fox Hunter operator to determine the correct compass bearing of the "FOX" transmitter. These techniques are high valued by Search and Rescue (SAR) Operations.

With no further business, President Kenny - WB3JEK adjourned the meeting at 2023 hours. The next BCARS meeting is scheduled for Thursday, 5 July 2017 at 1930 hours.
